★ **Neighbors InDeed Treasurer...**

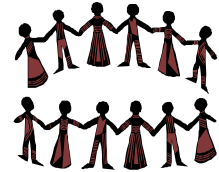

We are very grateful to the SCLH Association for giving us this opportunity to recruit new volunteers.

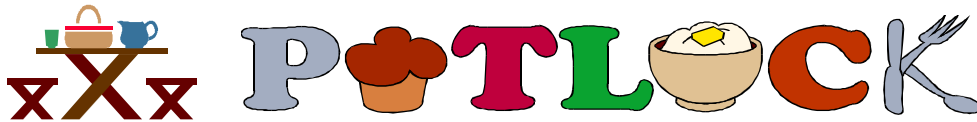

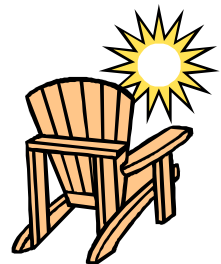
